RREUSE is a non-profit association representing social enterprises active in the field of re-use, repair and recycling.

RREUSE is looking for a full-time advocacy officer to join its Brussels-based secretariat for a fixed period of one year with the possibility of future extension.

Reporting to the secretariat's Director, the successful candidate will be expected to carry out tasks including:

- Policy monitoring, analysis and drafting of position papers primarily related to the EU's social economy, inclusion and employment agenda. There may also be scope to assist on other policy dossiers of relevance to RREUSE members, such as those related to the development of a circular economy, both environmental and fiscal in nature
- Representing RREUSE in relevant conferences, workshops and stakeholder events
- Support in research related to member activities
- Representing RREUSE in external projects where RREUSE is a partner
- Organisation of events/seminars
- Coordination of internal policy working groups
- Assisting in the drafting of funding applications

Skills and experience:

- A minimum of 1 year professional experience in EU affairs and advocacy with a sound understanding of EU policy processes. Familiarity in the field of EU social inclusion, employment or environmental policies will be considered an asset
- Excellent command of English (both written and spoken). In addition to English, proficiency in French and one other EU language will be considered an asset
- Strong project management, analytical and presentation skills
- Commitment and appreciation to the values of social enterprise and the environment
- Ability to work both independently and as a part of a team and coordinate members from different countries and backgrounds
